
## Pharmaceutical Sciences in Portugal

Providing a brief trail about the Pharmaceutical Sciences in Portugal: Since the late 16th century, the Apothecary Course and the School of Pharmacy - which gave rise to the Faculty of Pharmacy of the University of Coimbra - focusing initially on practical training; In the 18th century, Pharmacy Studies consists of two years of chemical operations practice (performed at the Chimico Laboratory) and two years of pharmaceutical operations practice (performed at the Pharmaceutical Dispensatory) - focusing on practical training. Only in 1836 were introduced in the formation in Pharmacy subjects of theoretical nature. In 1902, pharmaceutical education was first considered as higher education. This year's reform standardized the training of pharmacists in the country and containg both theory and practice.

Since pure chemistry to a more sociological perspective and joining to a medicine area, the evolution of Pharmaceutical Scienses performed a global public health stadium: Community pharmacy; Hospital pharmacy; Pharmaceutical industry; Clinical and genetic analysis; Public health; Education; Food and cosmetics industry; Clinical Trial Research; Regulatory Affairs; Clinic/Healthcare Management.
